• Historic falconry demonstrations

The history of falconry in Scotland holds a particular fascination for us. For this reason, we can accurately depict traditional falconry techniques and customs. This is especially good for re-enactment events, historical venues and education as well as general interest and entertainment. Attention to detail is paramount and so the costumes and species of birds used in the demonstrations are as historically correct as the available species will permit.



• Mounted falconry demonstrations

Mounted falconry demonstrations depict an ancient hunting scene with the King or Queen (or both) in pursuit of their prey and flying their falcons or hawks from horseback together with their falconers and dogs working with them. These can be carried out as interactive demonstrations by inviting children from the audience to come and act as 'beaters' as would have been the case historically.

• Interactive flying demonstrations

Your guests will always remember the day they had an owl fly silently over their heads or had a hawk fly through a tunnel of people or even tried to score a goal with a hawk as the keeper! Sound fun? It really is and it will give your guests an experience they will always remember as well as teaching them a lot about the behaviour of birds of prey.
